

Selection procedure/ eligibility criteria for Representing J&K UT/State in National chess events W.E.F. 2021-22

A- For Participation in J&K UT Events in Senior Open

- 4 Top position holders from previous year's Senior open(Entry fee = Nil)**
- 10 Top position holders from Kashmir Division senior open(Entry fee=Nil)**
- 10 Top position holders from Jammu division senior open(Entry fee=Nil)**
- 2 players on donor entry basis @Rs.5000/- per player (one from each division on basis of rank obtained in Kashmir/ Jammu division senior open events).**

Total maximum players allowed= 26. No. Of Total rounds = 6

B- For participation in J&K UT events in Women open

- 2 Top position holders from previous year's women open(Entry fee = Nil)**
- 4 Top position holders from Kashmir Division women open (Entry fee=Nil)**
- 4 Top position holders from Jammu division women open(Entry fee=Nil)**
- 2 players on donor entry basis @Rs.5000/- per player (one from each division on basis of rank obtained in Kashmir/ Jammu division senior women events) .**

C- For participation in J&K UT events in U-19 open

- 2 Top position holders from previous year's U-19 open(Entry fee = Nil)**
- 4 Top position holders from Kashmir Division U-19 open(Entry fee=Nil)**
- 4 Top position holders from Jammu division U-19 open(Entry fee=Nil)**
- 2 players on donor entry basis @Rs.5000/- per player (one from each division on basis of rank obtained in Kashmir/ Jammu division U-19 events) .**

D- For participation in J&K UT events in U-19 Girls

- 2 Top position holders from previous year's U-19 Girls (Entry fee = Nil)**
- 4 Top position holders from Kashmir Division U-19 Girls (Entry fee=Nil)**
- 4 Top position holders from Jammu division U-19 Girls (Entry fee=Nil)**
- 2 players on donor entry basis @Rs.5000/- per player (one from each division on basis of rank obtained in Kashmir/ Jammu division U-19 Girls events) .**

E- For participation in J&K UT events in U-15 open

2 Top position holders from previous year's U-15 open (Entry fee = Nil)

4 Top position holders from Kashmir Division U-15 open (Entry fee=Nil)

4 Top position holders from Jammu division U-15 open (Entry fee=Nil)

2 players on donor entry basis @Rs.5000/- per player (one from each division on basis of rank obtained in Kashmir/ Jammu division U-15 open events).

F- For participation in J&K UT events in U-15 Girls

2 Top position holders from previous year's U-15 Girls (Entry fee = Nil)

4 Top position holders from Kashmir Division U-15 Girls (Entry fee=Nil)

4 Top position holders from Jammu division U-15 Girls (Entry fee=Nil)

2 players on donor entry basis @Rs.5000/- per player (one from each division on basis of rank obtained in Kashmir/ Jammu division U-15 Girls events) .

Important Note for UT/ State Events – If a player wishes to participate in more than one categories , then organizers may charge entry fee of Rs.2000/- for participation in per additional event.

Note – District level events will be held without entry fee. (if a players wants to participate in more than one category then organizers may charge entry fee not more than Rs.500/- per player for per additional event).

Note – In Divisional Selection events organizers may charge entry fee not more than Rs.500/- per player for per category event.

Compulsory- In order to participate in any District ,Divisional, UT or National event a player must be registered with All India Chess Federation (AICF registration can be done on AICF website by uploading required data and reg fee directly to AICF online through AICF website).

Important note – Players in Senior open, Senior women, Junior boys and girls and Sub junior boys and Girls will be selected on basis of UT/State level events.(In case of emergency when UT event is not possible due to Jammu – srinagar highway road closure ,curfew or any other unforeseen reason ,then half players from Jammu Division and half from kashmir division may be allowed for Nationals).

Note- In age categories of U-7 Boys/Girls, U-9, U-11 ,U-13 and U-17 half players qualified from kashmir division and half players from Jammu division selection events will participate in Nationals.

Note – All players must abide by the rules and regulation of AICF and All J&K Chess Association. Decision of Executive committe of AJKCA will be final and binding on all J&K players.
